### **Prison for former activist's son for people trafficking. With Juan F Rocha**

Sayún was criminally prosecuted for people trafficking. According to reports from the Sub-Prosecutor's Office for Processes of the capital city, Omar's participation was proved, for which reason the Magistrates ordered the payment of a fine of 861,900 pesos.

The Higher Court of Justice of the Federal District sentenced Omar Sayún Gil to 15 years in prison following his arrest for people trafficking.

Magistrates of the Higher Court of Justice of the Federal District handling an appeal ordered the confirmation of the conviction of 15 years' imprisonment for Omar Sayún Gil, son of activist María Alejandra Gil Cuervo, Asociación Civil Pro Apoyo a Servidores (APROASE, A.C.) (Civil Association for the Support of Servers).

It was recalled that Sayún was criminally prosecuted for people trafficking. According to reports from the Sub-Prosecutor's Office for Processes of the capital city, Omar's participation was proved, for which reason the Magistrates ordered the payment of a fine of 861,900 pesos.

The space of Juan Francisco Rocha reported that Sayún's modus operandi was to travel through different states of the Mexican Republic, where he started relationships with young women for the purposes of marriage. Once he selected them, he showed them his large wealth so they would accept his marriage proposal.

Once he finished his, they travelled to Mexico City, where he threatened them, beat them and forced them into prostitution on the streets of the Cuauhtémoc delegation. The women were watched by Omar, María Alejandra Gil Cuervo and one of their accomplices. They are all now in prison after the victims reported it.
